# Sleepy Hollow -Wraparound Care

The Sleepy Hollow Group is withdrawing its Wraparound Day Care services at school with effect from 22 March 2016.

Next term Carniny Primary School will be organising the day care:

Breakfast Club -7.45-8.30am Waiting Club - 2.00-3.00pm After School Club-3.00-6.00pm (3.00-5.00 pm on Friday).

Initially this will be on a term time basis and will operate the same hours as previously with the exception on Friday when all children must be collected by 5pm. The same pricing structure will also be used.

Parents will need to complete new enrolment forms which are available from Sleepy Hollow (until the end of term) or from Miss K McCartney and the school office.

Forms must be returned to school before Wednesday 24 March.

# Parking at Carnview Park









I was recently invited to attend a meeting of local residents in Carnview Park along with representatives from EA and a local MLA and Councillor.

Tensions fears and frustrations of local residents are rising dramatically. They have requested the back pedestrian gate is closed forcing children to enter the school grounds via the Old Cullybackey Road. The Board of Governors has discussed the matter in the past and do not wish the gate to be closed. However it is something that will have to receive further consideration if no significant change to current parking practices is observed.


In our last newsletter parents and other drivers collecting children from school were asked to consider parking on the near side of Carniny Road and allowing the children to walk safely to and from school on Carnview Park. The residents acknowledged some drivers have taken this on board but the vast majority are still parking on Carnview Park causing continued obstruction to driveways and preventing service vehicles and residents from accessing homes between 2 and 3.10 pm.

The closure of the back gate is something the school does not want to see happen because of the inevitable inconvenience it will bring to children and parents. However if drivers are unable to show sympathy and respect for the residents by parking on the Carniny Road the Board of Governors will be forced to making a decision about the future of the back gate.

I trust we can have your cooperation in this matter.
