Sickness in School

If your child is ill, please have some consideration for his/ her classmates before sending him/her to school. The Department of Education Circular 1994/18 requires that children who are "ill with diarrhoea ('Tummy Bugs') should be kept from school until they are symptom free to minimise the spread of infection."

Normally children should not return to school for 48hrs after last episode of vomiting/diarrhoea.


