Child Protection / Volunteers

In accordance with the school's Child Protection Policy I would ask all parents who are interested in assisting voluntarily in any aspect of school life during 2019/2020 academic year (FOCPs, Transport, Library, School Visits etc.) to complete a Volunteer Application Form (available from the school office). In addition it will be necessary to complete the online Access NI form. Before beginning the online application you will require an instruction form including a PIN number. This can be obtained from the office. On completion of the online form you will receive a Unique Access NI Number which should be brought into school with relevant ID documents for verification. This procedure must be repeated annually.
